

Data policy

- Workshop presentation slides (Contributor presentations and cross-plotting presentations) will be made freely available on the workshop website.
- Contributors will be allocated anonymous random ID numbers for the cross plotting and the ID number allocations will not be publicised by the Organisers.
- Contributors are free to reveal their ID number if they wish to.
- Meta data (e.g. solver used, turbulence modelling approach used) will be allocated to ID numbers in order to be able to draw conclusions from the workshop results.
- The Organisers cannot rule out the possibility that ID number allocations may be indirectly deduced (e.g. from meta data).

After the workshop:

- Contributors grant non-exclusive rights to the Organisers to publish their data in anonymised form only (using ID numbers).
- The Organisers intend to publish the anonymised workshop results in various forms, for example:
 - Freely available scientific publications (conference presentation(s), journal paper(s)),
 - In an interactive online database (“Dashboard”) with access restricted to the Organisers and Contributors via an authentication system.
- In all such publications, the list of Contributors (names and institutions) will be acknowledged.
- A draft of each publication will be circulated among the Contributors for review, two weeks before publication. The Organisers will remove the data of any Contributor that makes such a request in writing within two weeks from receipt of the draft. If no response is received within two weeks, implicit approval for publication will be assumed.
- All Contributors retain unlimited rights to publish their own results independently.
- The rights granted by Contributors to the Organisers can be revoked at any time in writing, whereby the Contributor’s results will be deleted from the Dashboard and withheld from any future publications.
